A bargaining unit member the classifications Fire Captain, Training Officer/Deputy Chief, Firearms Instructor, Firefighter (Mechanic), and Firefighter I, Firefighter II who is required by the County to work on such a Holiday shall receive straight time compensation for the holiday hours actually worked.
