Pesticide Use Reporting Reminder

California law requires growers and applicators to submit pesticide use reports to the Agricultural Commissioner. This regulation applies to all pesticide applications (restricted and non-restricted). Failure to report pesticide use in an accurate and timely manner is a violation of Title 3 of the California Code of Regulations and is subject to enforcement action.

Electronic submission is now available. **Please contact our office to get setup with a webuser account.**

Please be aware that pesticides include, but are not limited to:

- Insecticides
- Adjuvants
- Herbicides
- Water run pesticides
- Rodent baits
- Pesticides used on ditch banks
- Sticker spreaders
- Fungicides (including dusting & wettable sulfur)
- Plant growth regulators
- Organic use pesticides
- Disinfectants/sanitizers (post-harvest commodity treatments)
- Commodities treated in warehouses (grains, seeds, etc.)

You may only use pesticide products that are registered in California and the label must specify your intended use.
