The 7th Safety member to be elected will be a Safety Member of the Imperial County Employees' Retirement System and will be elected solely by Safety Members of the System.

Petitions for the 7th Safety Member must be signed by not less than **FIVE (5)** Safety Members and must be filed with the Registrar of Voters not later than **October 20, 2017 at 5:00 pm**.

Who can run: Any Safety member of the Imperial County Employees' Retirement System.

Duties: Attend Retirement Board meetings and make decisions relating to administration of the retirement system, such as disability claims, buyback of retirement and investments.

Incumbent: Thomas Garcia

Term of Office: January 1, 2017 to December 31, 2020

Nomination Period: October 6, 2017 through October 20, 2017

Where to File: Elections Department, 940 Main Street, Ste. 206, El Centro

How Can I Run: Obtain nomination documents, secure five (5) valid signatures from Safety Members.

Voting: Voting will be by absentee ballot. Ballots will be distributed to Safety Members with the November 3rd payroll. Voted ballots must be returned to the Elections Department on or before November 28, 2017 by 5:00 p.m.

Candidates Statement of Qualifications: 200 words or less describing the candidate's qualifications for office that will accompany each ballot issued. The candidate's statement must be submitted by 5:00 pm on October 20, 2017 and must include a \$20.00 fee for an electronically filed statement.
